U19 AGE GROUP CHAMPIONSHIP

27 holes stroke play. Competitors must be under 19 years of age on 11th October, 2011. The winners of the tournament shall be the boy and girl (irrespective of age) who shot the best gross score and shall receive a trophy and prize.

The winner and runner-up in each division shall receive prizes for Best Gross, Best Nett and Best Stableford. **NOTE ONE PLAYER ONE PRIZE**

Divisions : Boys U19 U17 U15
Girls U19 U16

Any player under the age of 12 on 11th October, 2011 must have an adult (over 20 years) caddie on the course and who are NZ affiliated golfers.

CONDITIONS OF COMPETITION

1. Entries

- The tournament is open to male and female amateur players who are under 19 years of age on 11th October 2011 and who are NZ affiliated
- Entries must reach the office of Redwood Park Golf Club P.O.Box 95-142 Swanson Auckland (accompanied by the entry fee) no later than 4.00pm on Friday 30th September, 2011.
- Late or incomplete entries without fees will not be accepted
- **Handicap Index Limit:** The field will be limited to the 16 lowest handicapped entrants in each division.
- The Executive Board of Redwood Park Golf Club reserves the right to accept post entries for the event and to refuse any entry.
- The entry fee of \$20.00 covers the Tournament Rounds. and a practice round is available on Monday 6th September, 2010. A booking must be made through Redwood Park Office once the draw has been posted

2. Rules of play:

The rules of play shall be the Rules of Golf, as approved by the Royal and Ancient Golf Club of St. Andrews and The Local Rules of The Host Club.

- **Ties:** Tied scores for the overall tournament winner will be decided by a sudden death play-off, provided circumstances and daylight permit. In absence of such permitting circumstances, the title will be shared. All other ties will be decided by lot.
- **Starting Times, Postponements:** Competitors must be prepared to play whenever called upon to do so and any round may be postponed by the Committee to such an hour as may be thought fit. Players shall

start at the time and in the order arranged by the Committee. However it is a condition of this tournament that, in the absence of circumstances which warrant waiving the penalty of disqualification as provided in Rule 33-7, If the player arrives at a starting point ready to play within 5 minutes of his starting time”, the penalty for failure to start on time is 2 strokes, instead of disqualification.

- **Disputes:** Any dispute or protest must be lodged in writing with the office of Redwood Park within 15 minutes of the completion of the round in which the disputed matter has arisen.
- **Committee:** “The Committee” is the Committee in charge of the competition appointed by the Host Golf Club and will decide all disputes, or be responsible for all the arrangements and may if necessary postpone any round or alter the order of starting times. The decision of the Committee on these matters shall be final.
- **Caddies:** The use of motorized carts is not permitted. One caddy per player.
- **Registration:** Players must report to the start office **30 minutes** before their designated tee time, in the morning round.
- Players will be notified of the draw by email or mail one week prior to the Tournament.
- **Slow Play:** We sincerely hope that it will not be necessary to impose any penalties for slow play but action will be taken if a group gets “out of position”. Remember -- Your place in the field is directly behind the ones in front NOT directly in front of the ones behind. Don't look back – look forward. Out of position for this competition is when a group of players have clearly lost ground. They will be warned by a marshall or a referee and asked to make up ground. A referee will time slow play and a second warning will result in a 2 stroke penalty.
- **TIME LOCATION PER SHOT:** 50 seconds for the first player to play except on teeing grounds and greens 40 seconds for other shots. Timing starts when it is the players turn to play.
- **PROCEDURE FOR OFFICIAL:** Decide whether there are any mitigating circumstances. If so request the group regain position and monitor progress. If not, request they catch up and warn that if they do not do so, they will be timed. Once timing has started bad times and penalties are progressive.
- **1st BAD TIME** – noted and the player warned that a further bad time will result in a penalty.
- **2nd BAD TIME** – 2 stroke penalty in stroke play.
- **3rd BAD TIME** – disqualification.....
