**LOCAL RULES**

**NOTE – THESE ARE THE ONLY LOCAL RULES IN PLAY IN THIS TOURNAMENT.**

**OUT OF BOUNDS – Rule 27-1**

As defined by walls, fences, white lines or lines of white stakes.

**GROUND UNDER REPAIR**

For areas of Ground Under Repair enclosed by white lines, or Hydro-mulched areas (areas of new turf), relief **must** be taken in accordance with Rule 25-1.

**PROTECTION OF YOUNG TREES**

If a staked tree of any height, or an un-staked tree under two club-lengths in height, interferes with a player's stance or area of intended swing, the ball **must** be lifted without penalty and dropped in accordance with Rule 24-2b.

**BALL FOUND EMBEDDED BALL IN ITS OWN PITCH-MARK**

Rule 25-2 is extended to a ball lying in its own pitch-mark in an area Through the Green.

**PYLONS AND ELEVATED POWER LINES**

If a ball strikes a pylon or an elevated power line on the course, the stroke is cancelled and the player **must** play a ball as nearly as possible at the spot from which the original ball was played in accordance with Rule 20-5.

**BALL ACCIDENTALLY MOVED ON PUTTING GREEN**

Rules 18-2, 18-3 and 20-1 are modified as follows:

When a player's ball lies on the putting green, there is no penalty if the ball or ball-marker is accidentally moved by the player or her equipment.

The moved ball or ball-marker must be replaced as provided in Rules 18-2, 18-3 and 20-1.

This Local Rule applies only when the player's ball or ball-marker lies on the putting green and any movement is accidental.

**DISTANCE MEASURING DEVICES**

For all play in this tournament, a player may obtain distance information by use of a distance measuring device. If during a stipulated round, a player uses a distance measuring device to gauge or measure other conditions that might affect her play (e.g. elevation changes, wind speed, etc.), the player is in breach of Rule 14-3.

**PENALTY FOR PLAYING FROM A WRONG PLACE IN BREACH OF A LOCAL RULE – 2 STROKES**

If a ball has clearly not gone into a Water Hazard or Lateral Water Hazard, players are strongly advised to play a provisional ball should there be any doubt as to the location of their original ball.

**ALL PLAYERS MUST TAKE A SAND BUCKET TO REPAIR DIVOTS.  
PITCHMARKS MUST BE REPAIRED. BUNKERS MUST BE RAKED.  
FROM 1 JANUARY 2019, A COMMITTEE MAY GIVE PENALTY STROKES  
TO A PLAYER WHO DOES NOT DO THESE THINGS!**
